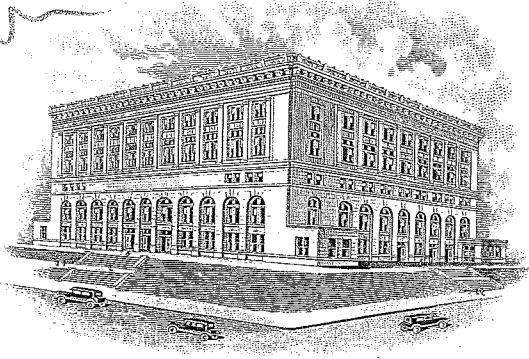

On October 25, 1939 we delivered to the City of Duluth three deeds covering lands acquired by the State of Minnesota for the Minnesota Point Project in St. Louis County.
